Trace presented on a draft air quality rule package regarding the National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) for a portion of Muskegon County. The draft rule package, which may impact some local businesses, involves a change in the NAAQS non-attainment designation for a portion of Muskegon County from a marginal classification to a more stringent moderate classification based on recent ozone monitoring data.
